Test to Stay

DHEC updated close contact quarantine protocols. As we have since the start of the pandemic, the Diocese of Charleston will follow their guidance. Please read below:

If an unvaccinated student or staff member is determined to have been in contact with someone with COVID-19, they would not have to quarantine at home but could continue attending school as long as they do not have symptoms, agree (for a child, their parents agree) to be tested and must wear a mask for 10 days. The individual must be tested within five days after the close contact and if they test negative, they can remain in school. If they test positive, they must isolate at home. The tests could be performed by parents at home using rapid tests. DHEC is making at-home tests available to schools so that schools can send home to parents for their use. I will let you know when these tests are available for our school community. St. Anthony School will not be administering rapid tests.

This week our school had 1 confirmed positive COVID-19 case in our student population. The 7-day average on the SCDHEC website is decreasing with the latest data published being 181.9. The good news is that the downward trend is moving rapidly.

Please pray for our Middle School students as they travel to the State House in Columbia! They will be touring the State House, attending an ESA hearing, and meeting the Governor!

Please keep our Second-Grade class in your prayers as they prepare for their First Reconciliation!
