Face Masks: Students and faculty will continue to be required to wear face masks while in the building.

Virtual Instruction: Teachers will no longer be required to stream instruction live through Google Meet while also teaching simultaneously in the classroom. Students that are under the new 5-day mandatory quarantine or isolation period may follow classroom lessons and activities directed from each teacher. If an entire class must quarantine or isolate, then virtual instruction via Google Classroom will occur.



New CDC Quarantine Guidelines

If Students/Staff Test Positive for COVID-19 (Isolate)

- Everyone, regardless of vaccination status.
 - Stay home for 5 days.
 - If you have no symptoms or your symptoms are resolving after 5 days, you can leave your house.
 - Continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days.
 - If you have a fever, continue to stay home until your fever resolves.

If a Student/Staff Were Exposed to Someone with COVID-19 (Quarantine)

- If student/staff, have been boosted OR completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine within the last 6 months OR completed the primary series of J&J vaccine within the last 2 months
 - Wear a mask around others for 10 days.
 - Test on day 5, if possible.
 - If student/staff develop symptoms he/she should get a test and stay home.
- If student/staff, completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine over 6 months ago and are not boosted OR completed the primary series of J&J over 2 months ago and are not boosted OR are unvaccinated
 - Stay home for 5 days. After that continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days.
 - Test on day 5 if possible.
 - If student/staff develop symptoms he/she should get a test and stay home.
