FAITH

Our school is welcoming and open to all faiths. Students learn about our Catholic Church tradition and teachings through daily religion classes, sacrament preparation and participating in our weekly school Mass. Students serve as readers, ushers, gift bearers, or in the Choir and Brass Ensemble.

Parish members and students are paired as Prayer Partners to share letters with uplifting messages and encouragement.

Fourth Grade students complete a Saint project which includes a presentation and dressing up as their chosen saint. Eighth grade students prepare a Faith Journey project in preparation for their Confirmation.

ARTS

Fine Art classes are taught to all students, 3K -8th grade. Music class is taught through the ORFF approach (music education combining music, movement, drama and speech lessons similar to a child's natural world of play).

Annual Musical Theater productions such as Mary Poppins Jr. and Willy Wonka Jr. Chorus, Band and a Brass Ensemble perform at Mass and SCISA Events, regional, district, state clinics, as well as community events.

KNOWLEDGE

Our school is accredited by AdvanceEd. Our class size is small (average of 10 students per class) creating a personalized learning environment. Our teachers attend Professional Development Trainings throughout the school year.

Student Success Coordinator is available to provide support for struggling learners and enrichment for high achieving students.

Science lab allows real, hands-on learning experiences through experiments and dissection. Technology lab with Mac Lab, iPads, robotics, Osmo, 3D printers and coding instruction.

Classrooms are equipped with interactive boards, use of iPads, Chromebooks (1:1 in 7th and 8th grades).

MAP Testing in Math, Reading, Language, and Science provides data for modified instruction of each student.

SPORTS

Students can compete in Basketball, Soccer, and Volleyball. 3K and older students are able to join Sports Clinics and Gymnastics. All students are taught PE and Health.

Older classes are paired with younger classes and sit together at weekly Mass.
