Just a few reminders to help carline move swiftly and safely.

- All students should exit the right side of the vehicle.

Accessing Family Portal

FACTS Family Portal is a private and secure parents' portal that will allow parents to view academic information specific to their children, while protecting their children's information from others. You can also communicate with teachers and other school staff online whenever necessary.

Here's how to access our easy-to-use Family Online:

- In Chrome, Firefox, Safari, or Internet Explorer go to www.factsmgt.com and click **Parent Login**, then select **FACTS Family Portal (ParentsWeb)**.
- Type the school's District Code: sat-sc
- Click Create New Family Portal Account.
- Type your email address and click **Create Account**. An email will be sent which includes a link to create your login. The link is active for 6 hours.
- From the email, click the link to create your Family Portal (ParentsWeb) login.
- A web browser displays your Name and FACTS SIS Person ID.
- Type a **User Name**, **Password**, and **Confirm** the password.



• Click Save User Name and/or Password.

A message displays at the top of the browser, "User Name/Password successfully updated."



- You may now log in to Family Portal using your new username and password.
- Family Portal allows you to access:
 - Student daily grades (Grades 4-8)
 - Lunch and School events and calendar
 - Important Documents

Here's how to access our easy-to-use **Family Online**:

- En Chrome, Firefox, Safari, o Internet Explorer, vaya a www.factsmgt.com y haga clic en Parent Login, luego selecciona FACTS Family Portal (ParentsWeb).
- Escriba el Código de Distrito del colegio Código de Distrito: sat-sc
- Haga clic en Create New Family Portal Account.
- Teclee su dirección de correo electrónico y haga clic en Create Account. Se le enviará un mensaje de correo electrónico en el que se incluirá un enlace para crear su usuario y contraseña para su cuenta de Family Portal. El enlace estará active durante 6 horas.
- Desde el correo electrónico, haga clic en el enlace para crear su inicio de sesión Family Portal (ParentsWeb).
- El navegador mostrará su nombre y su Person ID de FACTS SIS.
- Escriba un Nombre de Usuario, Contraseña, y Confirme la contraseña.
- Haga clic en Save User Name and/or Password.
 Un mensaje se mostrará en la en la parte de arriba del navegador: «User Name/Password successfully updated» (Usuario/Contraseña creados correctamente).
- En este momento ya puede accede a la Family Portal usando su Nuevo Usuario y Contraseña.
- Family Portal le permitirá accede a :
 - Asistencia del alumno y evaluación diaria. (for Grades 4th -8th only)
 - Eventos del colegio y menús del comedor.
