Welcome to September! So many events are happening around our school community! MAP testing is underway! But what is MAP (Measures of Academic Progress) testing all about?


Unlike paper-and-pencil tests, where all students are asked the same questions and spend a fixed amount of time taking the test, MAP Growth is a computer-adaptive test. That means every student gets a unique set of test questions based on responses to previous questions. The purpose of MAP Growth is to determine what the student knows and how they are growing academically. It is designed to measure student achievement in the moment and growth over time.

MAP Growth tracks students' wherever they are starting from and regardless of the grade they are in. For instance, if a third grader is reading like a fifth-grader, MAP Growth will be able to identify that. Or, if a fifth grader is doing math like a third-grader, MAP Growth will identify that, too. Both things are incredibly important for a teacher to know so that they can plan instruction efficiently. St. Anthony students, grades 5K-eighth take the MAP test three times per year. It is important to remember this is not the only data we use to assess and drive student learning. MAP assessments, joined with other data points, provide detailed, actionable data about where each child is on his or her unique learning path.



Scrip News New Name, New Vendor, Big Sale

New Name - Our scrip vendor has officially transitioned to the name RaiseRight for their website (RaiseRight.com) and the mobile app. The website was formerly known as ShopWithScrip. If you already had an account on the website or the app, your account info and sign-in information will remain the same.

New Vendor – Publix physical gift cards are now available in \$25 and \$100 denominations. The discount percentage is 2.5%. If there is an interest, I will start stocking them in the school office. They are available now for special order.

Big Sale - Raise Days - September 15 & 16
