Lighthouse Ministries Working Mothers Education and Support Program is a six-month comprehensive program that provides low-income mothers with life skills classes and money management sessions. The program also ensures that mothers have a six-month supply of diapers, wipes, baby lotion, baby wash, and laundry detergent for each of their small children.

St. Jerome became so famous for knowing scripture that the pope asked him to help translate the Bible into Latin so that more people at that time and place could read it. St. Jerome is considered a Father and Doctor of the Church. His feast day is September 30.

The St. Anthony House System

The "house" system has its roots in the British school system where boarding students are divided into mixedage groups in order to help meet their basic physical, emotional, and social needs and to create a sense of a "family". Catholic schools, in particular, have begun to use the house system to promote positive character traits as well as to instill a sense of belonging and group pride.

St. Anthony has four different houses to which students may be assigned. The goal is for members to remain in the same house until they graduate from St. Anthony. However, changing demographics may result in a need to reassign houses. At the beginning of each school year students participate in the House Sorting Ceremony. Students new to St. Anthony are assigned to houses. Sibling groups are always placed in the same house.

Each house is named after a saint and has a motto, color, and shield. Two teachers in each house serve as deans to oversee the house, and support the house leadership. The house leadership consists of a Prefect, an Assistant Prefect, a Scribe, and a Parliamentarian. The house leadership helps plan and lead the house meetings that occur once a month.

House members work together to earn points for their house. Students will learn to work hard individually for the good of their house, along with working as a house team. Our house system encourages teamwork, friendship, cooperation, and leadership.
