#### **Protective Face Coverings**

The CDC gives updated guidance to schools as more information becomes available. While neck gaiters were initially considered effective, the CDC is currently discouraging their use. They are less effective than cloth masks.

We are requesting that students discontinue the use of neck gaiters. **Students should wear cloth face masks.** Face shields are provided at school for students to use as appropriate.

**FACTS Management** gives you, the busy parent, an opportunity to get more involved in your child's academic progress and future success – all via the Internet!

**FACTS Family Portal** is a private and secure parents' portal that will allow parents to view academic information specific to their children, while protecting their children's information from others. You can also communicate with teachers and other school staff online whenever necessary.

Here's how to access our easy-to-use Family Online:

- In Chrome, Firefox, Safari, or Internet Explorer go to <u>www.factsmgt.com</u> and click **Parent Login**, then select **FACTS Family Portal (ParentsWeb)**.
- Type the school's District Code: sat-sc
- Click Create New Family Portal Account.
- Type your email address and click **Create Account**. An email will be sent which includes a link to create your login. The link is active for 6 hours.
- From the email, click the link to create your Family Portal (ParentsWeb) login.
- A web browser displays your Name and FACTS SIS Person ID.
- Type a User Name, Password, and Confirm the password.
