In May 2021, Pope Francis invited the global Catholic Church to gather and reflect on communion, participation, and mission within the Church. The twoyear process of listening and dialogue is themed, "For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation, & Mission," being referred to as the "Synod on Synodality," which the Holy Father officially opened with Mass at Saint Peter's Basilica on Oct. 10.

The Diocese of Charleston joins dioceses throughout the world in the next phase of the synod which includes consultation and dialogue at the diocesan level. Using a preparatory document and questionnaire to guide the discussion from the Holy See's synod office, this phase runs through April 2022. Bishop Robert E. Guglielmone explains the process in this short video.
