Parents can apply for Parental Refundable Tax Credit now. The South Carolina Department of Revenue (SCDOR) will begin accepting applications for the 2020 Parental Refundable Tax Credit on January 15, 2021. Learn more below.

Important information:

- Parents must submit Parental Refundable Credit applications online using the SCDOR's free and secure tax portal, MyDORWAY. The SCDOR will not accept paper, faxed, or emailed applications.
- A <u>new tutorial</u> is available to show applicants how to submit the application through MyDORWAY.
- Details about the application and the application process are available at <u>dor.sc.gov/exceptional-sc</u>.
- Applicants should sign up for MyDORWAY now, so they'll be ready to submit applications on January 15, 2021.
