I am especially grateful to Father John, whose strength, encouragement, and spiritual guidance have been a true anchor for me throughout this process. I also want to thank our outstanding teachers and staff for their unwavering support, not only in this decision but throughout my entire time here. It has been a privilege to serve alongside such faithful and passionate educators.

To ensure the continued success and stability of our school for the 2025-2026 school year, the Diocese of Charleston will partner with St. Anthony to begin a formal, rigorous search for the next principal. In the meantime, an interim principal will be appointed to maintain continuity and keep our mission moving forward. I will be finishing the 2024-2025 school year and on campus until June 30th.

I am filled with gratitude for every moment spent here at St. Anthony Catholic School. Please know that wherever God leads me, I will always carry this community in my heart and prayers. I ask for your continued prayers as I take this next step, and I will be praying for all of you and the bright future of this beautiful school.
